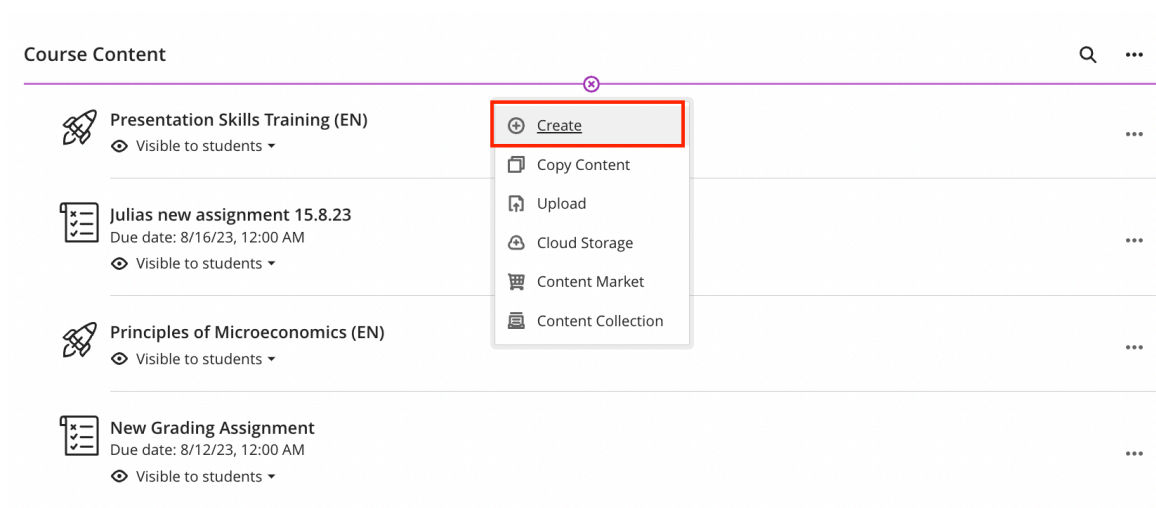


How to embed a Lecturio Video Course in a Blackboard Assignment

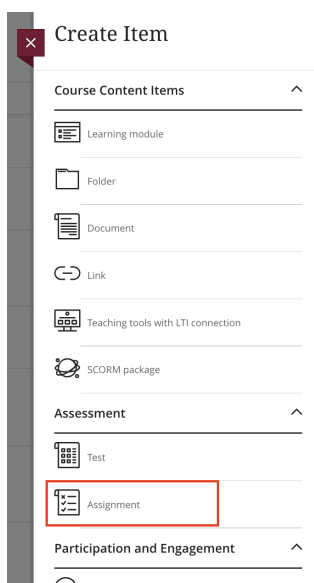
The following instructions provide the steps to deep-link a Lecturio video course in a Blackboard assignment. ***The process to deep-link a Lecturio Qbank test or Concept Page follows the same steps.***

The progress of students will be reflected in the Blackboard grade book.

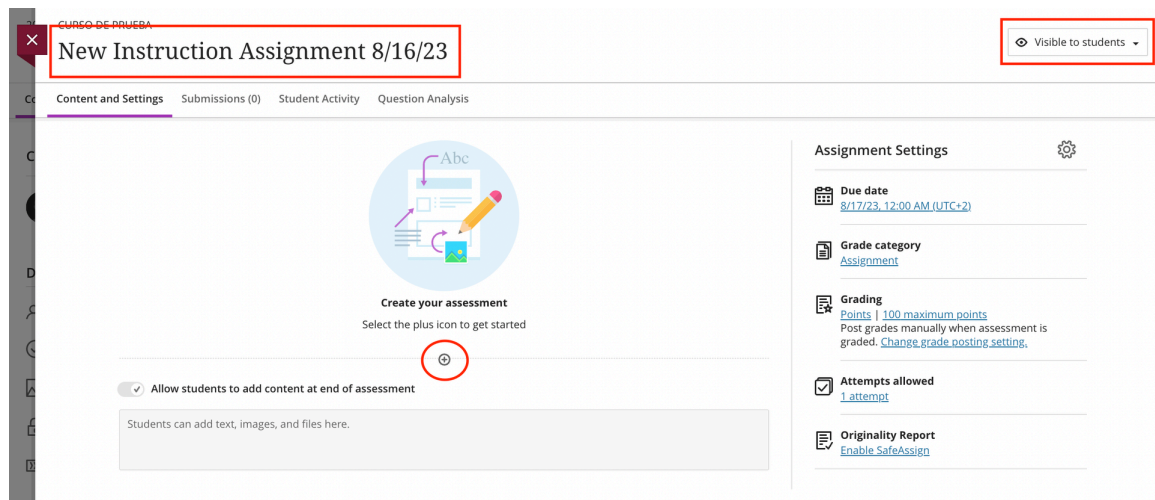
1. Please click on the plus symbol (“+”) to deep-link the video course in the **Blackboard Course Content** page and select “**Create**”:



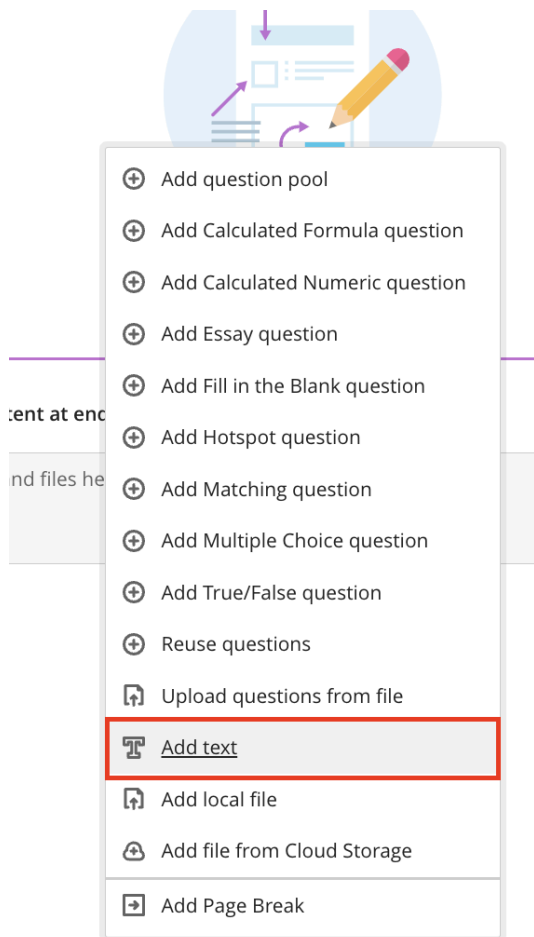
2. On the page shown below, click on “**Assignment**”:



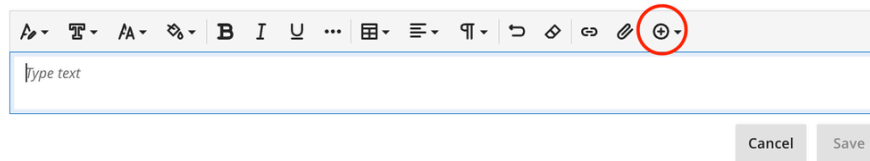
3. Enter a **name** for the assignment. Turn on “**Visible to Students**” from the drop-down menu in the top right. Click on “**+**”:



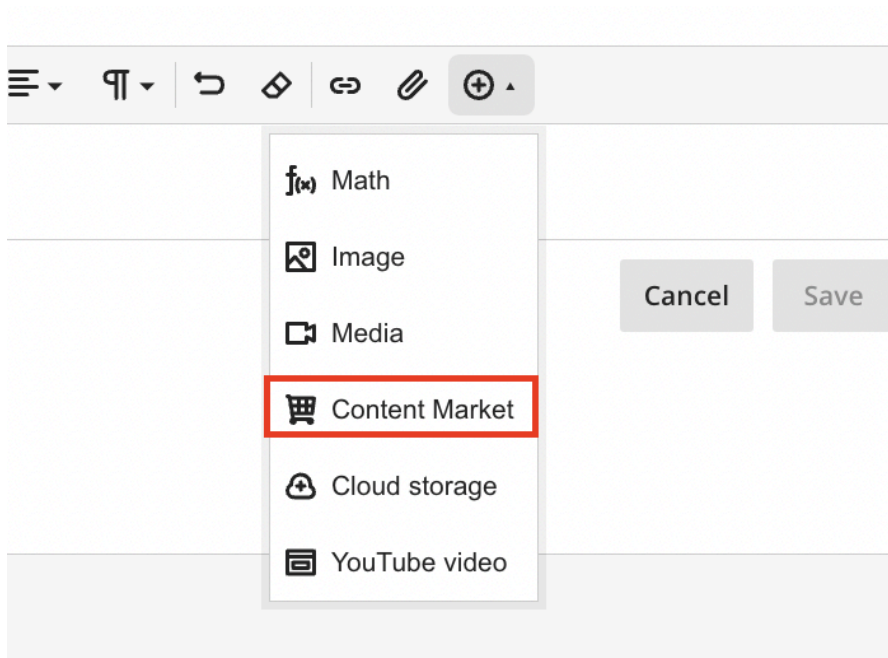
4. Select “**Add Text**” option from the drop-down menu:



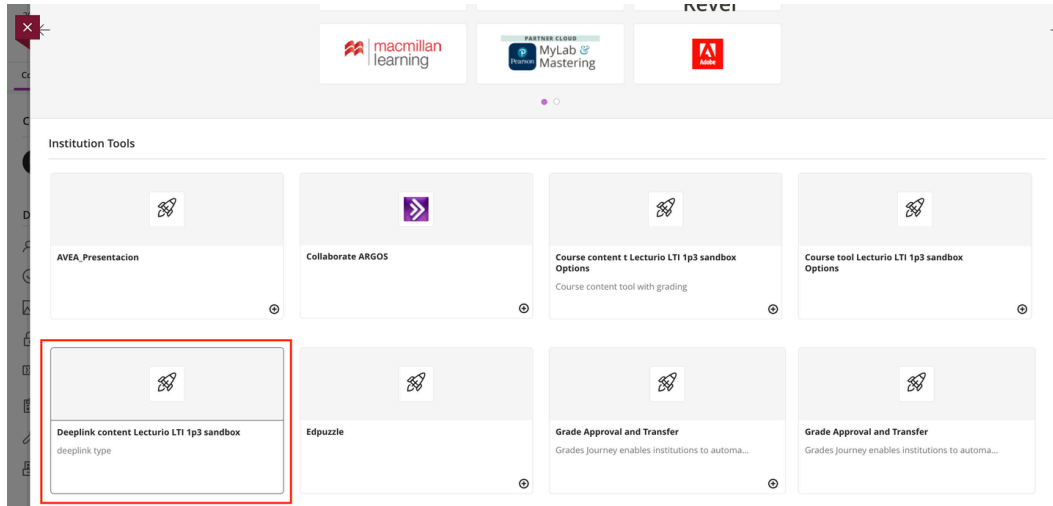
5. Click on “+” in the text field:



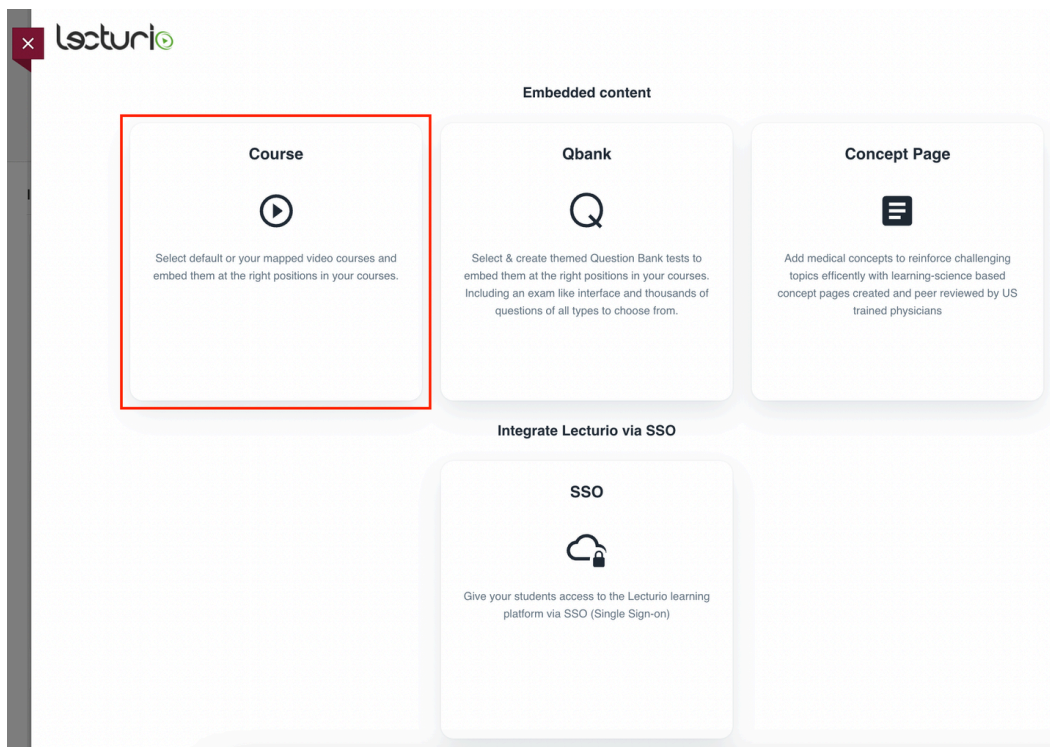
6. Select “**Content Market**” from the drop-down menu:



7. Select the Lecturio tool as shown below:



8. In the Tool Picker, click the **Course** card to embed a course:




