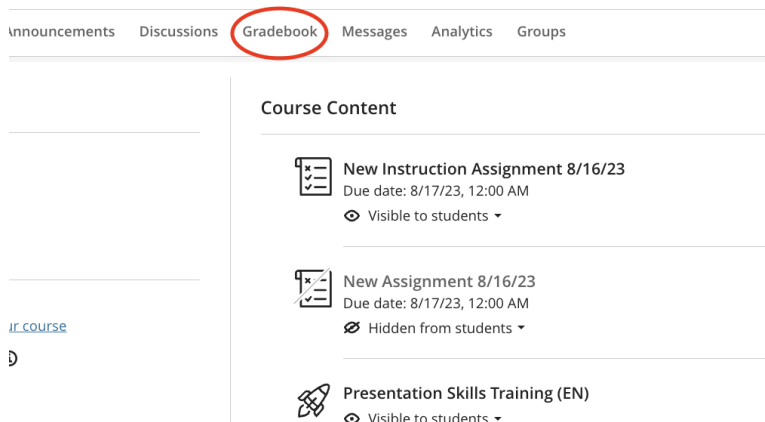


Lecturio - How Grading Works on Blackboard

The following instructions provide the steps to check grades for embedded Lecturio content in Blackboard.

1. To check grades for any course, click on “Gradebook” tab.



2. On the page shown, you can see the students' grades for all assignments.

3. For Course, Qbank and Concept pages the grading systems are different.

- a. **For a course**, the student's progress percentage for the course is transferred as the final grade on the Gradebook.
